The Montefiore School of Nursing is seeking an experienced Nursing Educator. This faculty position could be filled with a tenure-track or non-tenured faculty member with recent experience in at least one of the following areas:

Primary duties may include but are not limited to the following:

- Teach a full load of theory (typically 7-8 credit hours), and clinical courses (typically 8 contact hours) each academic year (Fall and Spring semesters).

- Serve as team lead for adjunct faculty teaching clinical rotations in associated theory course.
- Provide professional academic advisement/mentoring to students.
- Lead course development and participate as a member of the curriculum committee for curriculum development.
- Lead program accreditation and continuous improvement activities.
- Function as an effective, active, and collegial team member.
- Actively participate in service to the School Of Nursing and professional community.
